





# Descriptive Report on Parent-Teacher Meet Held on 18.06.2022

A parent teacher meet was organized in the premises of S.J.K.College, Kalanaur on 18th June, 2022 from 12.45p.m onwards for the academic session 2021-2022.

A formal invitation was sent to all the parents through personal messengers and as well as by post. The meeting was attended by 74 parents/guardians form different U.G./PG programmes. In Addition to personal interactions with teachers, staff and Principal, a formal feedback Performa was also given to them for seeking genuine and frank opinion for 12 identified areas. Percentage was calculated for all twelve areas and average scores were calculated for the last 10 areas.

- > 100% of the parents have reported that information given about performance/attendance of the ward is shared time to time though telephonic message and institution regularly conducts the programs for the enhancement of students development.
- Rest of the items were given weights against their responses which may vary from 1 to 4.
