Number of students

In the session 2016-17 total 420 students took admission in the College, out of which 175 were boys and 203 were girls. 305 students were enrolled in Arts faculty, 108 in Commerce. Self financed B.Sc classes are also running regularly.

Faculty

06 Associate and 09 Assistant Professor are working in the College on regular basis. During this session 05 teachers are working on contractual basis. Administrative staff comprising of Head Clerk Sh. Madhu Sudan Sharma, Clerk Sh. Sanjay Kumar, Sh. Naresh Kumar and Sh. Hemant Kumar play active role in the smooth and effective functioning of the College. There are 09 regular fourth class employees, 06 employees are appointed on adhoc basis.
