SESSION 2018-2019

New session started on 18th July, 2018 with the chanting of mantras in a Hawan Ceremony. Sh. Shadi Lal Batra (President, Sat Jinda Kalyana Managing Committee) alongwith Sh. Mahender Khurana, Sh. Bharat Bhushan Bathla, Sh. Om Praksh Dang, Principal Dr. Naresh Kumar Dua lighted the lamp. Revered Mahant Khushhal Dass Ji graced the occasion by being there and addressing the people assembled there. Dr. Naresh Kumar Dua welcomed the new students and made them aware about the rules and regulations of the college. The college magazine 'Vidyankur' was released on this day. Number of students

In the session 2018-19, 575 students took admission in the college, out of which 247 were boys and 328 were girls students. 403 students were enrolled in Arts faculty, 131 in Commerce faculty, 19 in B.Sc. & BCA and 22 in PGDCA. At present 57% of the total number of students is girls.
