SESSION 2021-2022

Number of students and courses

This is a matter of pleasure that in the session 2021- 22 college became Post-Graduate college. In this session total 611 students took admission in the college out of which 270 were boys and 341 were girls. 398 students were enrolled in Arts faculty, 88 in Commerce faculty, 30 in Science faculty, 28 students took admission in M.A. Geography and 31 students took admission in M.Com.

Faculty

Apart from Principal Dr Naresh Kumar Dua, 7 Associate and 10 Assistant Professors (including librarian) are working in the college on regular basis. 12 teachers were appointed on contractual basis during the session. For the smooth and effective functioning of the college administrative office 3 non -teaching employees are working on regular basis and 01 on contractual basis. There are 9 class IV employees out of which 01 is on regular basis and 8 are on contractual basis.

Result of the Examination

Students of our college always stand in the merit list of MD University Rohtak. In the examination conducted in March 2021, Ashish, a student of B.Com Semester-I brought laurels to the college by standing first in the whole University and student Sarla stood 17th in the university merit list. In the examination conducted in July 2021 student Pooja of BA Sem VI stood first in the whole University and student Mitali of B.Com Sem II stood 9th, Shruti stood 20th and Mausam stood 42nd in the University merit list.

It is a matter of great pride and pleasure that 17 students of our college were named in the University merit list of Maharshi Dayanand University, Rohtak in the examination conducted in February 2022. In this list Jyoti of APGDCA got 21st and Ravinder 22nd position, Hema of BA Semester I got 48th and Kirthi and Kanta got 50th position jointly Anjali of BA Sem III got 48th position, Radhika of B. Com Semester I got 26th position, Himanshi got 45th position. Ashish of B.Com Semester III got 14th position, Sonia of B.Com Semester V got 47th position and Pinky same class got 48th position. Muskan of BCA Semester III got 39th position. Sunaina of MA Geography Semester I got 34th, Neha got 39th and Ashish got 46th position. Mausam of M. Com Semester I got 44th and Shruti of the same class got 49th position in the University merit list.
