Based on the Student Satisfaction Survey and feedback collected from students, teachers, employers and alumni, the following actions have been taken:

S. N.	Observations/Suggestions	Action Taken
1.	The library facilities, such as Wi-Fi and syllabus-related books, should be enhanced.	The college has upgraded its Wi-Fi facility by procuring three optical fibre connections, each with a bandwidth of 200 Mbps, replacing the earlier 70 Mbps Wi-Fi connections.
2.	The library should permit the issuance of at least five books per student until the end of the semester.	
3.	Classrooms' infrastructure should be further upgraded to enhance the teaching and learning environment.	The college management has accepted the proposal to construct some new classrooms.
4.	There should be more emphasis on practical learning.	As the curriculum is designed by the affiliating university, MDU, Rohtak, the relevant suggestions have already been submitted to the university in previous years. Further, with the implementation of the National Education Policy (NEP), internships have become an integral component of every programme, with a strengthened emphasis on skill development and employability.
5.	There should be more involvement of degree college teachers while designing the curriculum.	
6.	The curriculum should be linked to internships, placements, or employment opportunities.	
7.	More postgraduate (PG) programmes should be introduced in the college.	The college currently offers three postgraduate programmes and intends to introduce a B.P.Ed. programme in the near future.
8.	Various cultural and sports activities should complement the curriculum.	The college has organised several cultural programmes in the past and intends to organise more in the future. Additionally, the Sports In-Charge has been asked to place greater emphasis on enhancing student participation in sports and gymnasium activities.
9.	The college should place greater emphasis on encouraging student participation in the gymnasium and sports activities.	

10.	Lawns and green areas of the campus should be maintained more systematically.	The college management has been requested to appoint an additional gardener. Further, the concerned support staff have been instructed to give greater attention to the cleanliness and hygiene of the campus. The college also regularly organises cleanliness campaigns and drives.
11.	Greater attention should be given to maintaining campus hygiene.	
12.	A security guard should be stationed at the main gate to restrict the entry of outsiders, and the wearing of I-Cards should be made mandatory for all students.	The request to appoint a security guard has been accepted by the college management, and the appointment will be made shortly. Wearing of I-cards has already been made mandatory for all students on the campus.
13.	More educational tours and fieldwork activities should be organised to provide practical exposure.	Fieldwork is conducted in accordance with the prescribed curriculum, and educational tours are organised from time to time.
14.	Laboratory, canteen, and first-aid facilities should be further improved.	The concerned In-Charges were asked to do the needful.
15.	Greater emphasis should be placed on group discussions during classroom teaching.	The suggestions and observations were communicated to the staff members, and they were instructed to take appropriate and necessary actions.
16.	Teachers should actively identify students' weaknesses or grievances and support them in addressing and overcoming these issues.	
17.	The use of ICT tools in teaching should be enhanced.
